- Make every effort to employ qualified candidates that fall around the midpoint of salary ranges, based on years of experience.


## Philosophy

All positions have a maximum placement rate reached at 10 years of experience

- At 10 years of employment at KCKPS, employee starts receiving Longevity bonuses.
- Any future increases to the base wage will be based on Board approved Salary Schedule Adjustments. All employees on step 10 will get the Salary Schedule Adjustments, but will not receive any additional $\%$ increases.

Years of experience from outside the district will be credited on a $2: 1$ exchange and limited to 10 years of credit

- i.e. 4 years of experience outside the district equal 2 years of experience for rate placement

Prior years of experience must be directly applicable to current position held.

- All supervisory and administration roles must include leadership for the years of experience to be considered for rate placement
- Driver roles must include CDL usage for the years of experience to be considered for rate placement
- Nutritional services roles must include food service for the years of experience to be considered for rate placement
- Roles with increased responsibility will be compensated based on market rate for applicable experience, which will not necessarily include lower level position experience.

Increases after initial placement on pay schedules will be based on annual board approved increases.
